DC Department of Transportation (DDOT) is pleased to announce the 31st Street Bridge over the C&O Canal will be re-opening to all traffic effective Thursday, January 14th 2021 at 10:00 AM.

DDOT thanks all residents and business for their patience and support through the duration of this critical project in their community. The fully rehabilitated new bridge structure includes: the resetting of the supporting pier, lateral supports for the canal's existing walls, new safety railings and wider ADA-compliant brick sidewalks and ramps.
